**WAIVER OF 1-YEAR WAIT REQUIREMENT FOR ELIGIBLE PERSONS
BETWEEN 16-18 YEARS OF AGE TO TAKE THE GED EXAM**

GED Standard Policy requires that eligible persons between 16-18 years old must have been withdrawn from a regular K-12 instructional program for a period of at least one year before being allowed to take the GED exam.
